Day 01: Tirana Airport – Shkodra (87km – 1h 30min)

WELCOME IN ALBANIA!!
Arrival in Tirana Airport and transfer to Shkodra

Enjoy an afternoon sightseeing tour of the city. The architectural elements indicate a mix from the Ottoman, Austrian, Italian and communist architectural styles.

To try during the dinner:
The variety of meat dishes include veal, seasonal goat, wild pork fillet and grilled vegetables.

Overnight in Shkodra: Hotel Alis 4*, or Tradita Gheg and Tosk 3*, or similar

Day 02: Shkodra – Kruja (88km – 1h 30min)

AM: Visit the VENETIAN ARTS MASK FACTORY in Shkoder. By coming to the source you can not only see how they are produced but can purchase your own mask at a greatly reduced price.

Our journey will take you to the captivating legendary castle of Rozafa, overlooking Shkoder (Skadar) lake and Adriatic Sea, once the stronghold of the brave Adrian Illyrian tribe. Join us to explore the mix of the ancient and modern trail of history and traditions of locals in the north western Albania.

PM: To try during the lunch: Lunch on the way to Kruja – Mrrizi i Zanave Agritourist farm (30 min from Shkodra)
The tantalizing dishes include baked cheese, clay baked lamb, wild mushrooms, wild blueberries, pitas from homegrown corn.
Continue to Kruja. (1.5 hrs.) The walking tour takes you through the Ottoman bazaar, wooden shops and displays various gifts and antique items for the home.
(Specialty to try for dinner: Fergesë me mish viçi (Furghes with Veal; the dessert called KABUNI - a traditional Albanian dessert.

Overnight in Kruja: Hotel Panorama 3+*, or similar

Day 03: Kruja – Berat (135km – 2h 30min)

AM: KRUJA, is considered one of the principal old town and is one of the most glorious cities in Albania. Visit the castle walls, Historical Museum dedicated Skanderbeg, and an old house converted into an ethnographic museum, invites you to a special cultural aspect of life in northern Albania.
PM: Well-known Uka Farm is enriched with a new concept, known as “from farm to table”, or paraphrased, everything from the earth to the table. Exclusive foods made in Albania or better, made in Uka Farm

Continue our driving to Berat (120 km – 2 hrs.)
Visitors will find a special welcome, pleasant environments of relaxing, enjoying the traditional characteristic cuisine with famous homemade cooking in a traditional house in Berat. Berat olives, pie, stuffed grape leaves, wine and raki (traditional alcoholic drink)

Overnight in Berat: Hotel Grand White City 4*, or similar

Day 04: Berat – Tirana (135km – 2h 30min)

AM: BERAT - Known as the “City of one thousand windows” is declared a Museum City” and is listed under UNESCO World Heritage Medieval Sites. The town is composed of 3 parts; Gorica, situated on the far side of the river; Mangalem, situated on the fortress side of the river and the Residential quarter within the fortress known as Kalaja. The old part of the city has some religious buildings like mosque and Byzantine churches. Visit the Fortress; The Onufri’s Museum

PM: Wine testing in Cobo Winery – Wine testing: The Çobo Winery is scenically nestled at the base of Mt. Tomorri in the rolling hills that surround the city of Berat.



Çobo’s facilities currently consist of several cultivated vineyards, a spacious kulla (a form of traditional Albanian architecture), and the winery itself, and a wine presentation room, elegantly constructed and furnished in the Berat style. Proceed driving to Tirana (2h30min)

Overnight in Tirana: Hotel Metro 4*, or Opera 4*, or similar

Day 05: Tirana – Airport (20km – 30min)

AM: Tirana, the capital of Albania, is the biggest city in Albania, with a long history enriched by the interaction of cultural forces originating in the Islamic and European Christian worlds. During the tour, you will encounter the impact of these influences in the Tirana’s architecture. The tour will highlight some symbols and remains of the communism era to provide you with a general understanding of Albanian history.
Visit of the National Historic Museum & Bunk’Art Museum

To try during the tour: A special dinner in a traditional old house with good wine, tasting local dishes like: Tave Kosi (baked lamb with yoghurt), also known as Tave Elbasani, after the city in central Albania where it originates

Unforgettable memories of charming journey through Albania – Northern Greece and North Macedonia. Touch history and UNESCO Heritage Sites, enjoy wonderful landscape drive and taste delicious cuisine of Balkans.

Day 01: Tirana APT – Kruja (26km – 30min)

Meet and greet the guests at Tirana International Airport and transfer to Kruja hill town (30min)
 PM – KRUIJA, is considered one of the principal old town and is one of the most glorious cities in Albania. Visit the castle walls, Historical Museum dedicated Skanderbeg, and an old house converted into an ethnographic museum, invites you to a special cultural aspect of life in northern Albania.

Overnight in Kruja: Hotel Panorama 3*+ or similar

Day 02: Kruja – Berat – Vlorë (246km – 4h30min)

AM – Today, we'll head to Berat, a medieval town listed under UNESCO World Heritage Sites. We will walk up at the fortress and visit its unique architecture of stone houses, of multiple window buildings; walls and towers, orthodox churches and mosques, reflecting the harmonious coexistence between the Muslim population and the Orthodox Christian, a very positive example for the whole world. Enjoy your visit of Onufri Museum. Take some unforgettable pictures of the city of the "windows one above the other"

PM: Tour & Wine Testing in Cobo Winery (Optional). The winery is scenically nestled at the base of Mt. Tomorri in the rolling hills that surround the city of Berat. Cobo's facilities currently consist of several cultivated vineyards, a spacious kulla (a form of traditional Albanian architecture), and the winery itself, and a wine presentation room, elegantly constructed and furnished in the Berat style.

Continue our drive to Vlorë city

Overnight in Vlorë: Hotel Partner 4* or similar

Day 03: Vlorë – Saranda – Butrinti – Gjirokastra (280km – 6hrs)

Today we'll have a long drive along the breathtaking Albanian Riviera. Enjoy the scenic mountain ride, descending the rocky shore and pristine beaches of Ionian Sea, offering photo opportunities of the natural landscape & unique village settings. Upon arrival to Saranda, lunch and then visit of Butrinti Archaeological Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and a Ramsar Wetland Site of International Importance (two very important titles). This impressive walking tour will stir your imagination about the ancient world



during the peak of the Roman power and the classical Greek mythology. Start with the Asclepius temple, theatre, Roman portico and baths, early Christian baptistry, byzantine basilica, defensive walls and their impressive gates. After a wonderful walk in Butrinti Natural Park, transfer to Gjirokastra.

Overnight in Gjirokastra: Hotel Argjiro 4* or similar



Day 04: Gjirokastra – Ioannina – Kalambaka (200km - 4 hrs.)

Many houses in Gjirokastra have a distinctive local style that has earned the city the nickname "Stone Town". Visit of the Castle and explore the old town, the bazaar, with its characteristic shops and great opportunity to interact with local folks. This UNESCO site has something unique to offer to his visitors. Continue driving to Ioannina/GRECCE. *Please note, border procedures and time difference between Albania & Greece: 0/+1*
 Enjoy lunch in Ioannina and some free time in the city center. Proceed driving to Kalambaka, with stop en route for refreshments.
 Overnight in Kalambaka: Hotel Meteora 4* or similar

Day 05: Kalambaka – Bitola – Ohrid (300km – 5hrs)

Today we'll start the visit of the Monasteries. METEORA - is actually a religious place with many Byzantine churches and Monasteries, built on top of rocks that looks like hanging rocks, overlooking a beautiful valley. Visit of two Monasteries the Holy Monastery of Varlaam & Monastery of St. Stephan

Important notice: For entering the monasteries of Meteora, appropriate clothing is required. Ladies must not wear short skirts and must have long sleeves. Men are not allowed to wear shorts. However, all the monasteries have wrap skirts at the entrances that you can borrow

After the visit, we'll drive towards North Macedonia AM – Enjoy the drive through northern Greece, crossing the border to Macedonia, with stop en route for lunch.

Please note, border procedures and time difference between Greece & North Macedonia: 0/-1

After the border crossing, we may stop for a sightseeing of Bitola city, an administrative, cultural, industrial, commercial, and educational center and one of the oldest cities on the territory in the Republic of Macedonia, founded by Philip the second. Have a nice walk to Sirok Sokak, before our departure to Ohrid.

Overnight in Ohrid: Hotel SU 4* or similar

Day 06: Ohrid – St. Naum – Ohrid (70km – 2hrs)

Breakfast in the hotel, and start the tour of Ohrid Old Town, which is situated at the lake side resort of Ohrid, classified as a UNESCO's World Cultural Heritage site. Nicknamed the 'Jerusalem of the Balkans', Ohrid is one of the oldest settlements in Europe, and was once considered to be the epicenter of religion and Slavic culture. Its history is evident in every building that lines the city's old town.

Visit St. Bogorodica Perivlepta Church & St Sophia Cathedral and the stunning St. John Kaneo Church (outside only).
 After lunch at a local restaurant in the old town, enjoy a boat ride on this extraordinary lake (Optional)
 Afternoon optional visit to a monastic complex of St. Naum

Overnight in Ohrid: Hotel SU 4* or similar

Day 07: Ohrid – Tirana (140km – 3h30min)

AM – After breakfast at the hotel departure to Tirana/ALBANIA with stop en route for refreshments.
Please note, border procedures: Guests are kindly asked to keep their passports handy

PM –We shall explore the capital city of Albania, including some of the historical highlights, as city Centre, Skanderbeg Statue, Et'hem Bey Mosque, Clock tower, Italian buildings and Martyrs of the Nation Boulevard. Visit the ex-communist buildings, painted with vibrant colors and the expansion of city.

Overnight in Tirana: Hotel Colosseo 4*, or Opera 4* or similar

Day 08: Tirana – Tirana APT (20km – 30min)

AM – Morning time to explore Tirana market place, or shopping. Visit of National Historic Museum

G005 8 Days Tour in Montenegro - North Albania - Kosovo - North Macedonia - Greece

Travel across the heart of Balkan Peninsula and discover the similarities and diversities of geographical, historical, socio-cultural and ethnic aspects. Indeed, history is full of sudden burst of the strong Balkan passions. But wars are left in the past. We can now only enjoy the beautiful features of the sunny face of the Balkans – beautiful and preserved nature, old monasteries, cozy towns – a different and slightly old-fashioned Europe.

Day 01: Podgorica APT – Transfer to Budva (70km – 1h30min) (Montenegro)

Meet and greet the group at Podgorica International Airport, and transfer to Budva (65km – 1h30min)

(Please let us know your flight details in order to organize the first and the last day)

Optional boat tour - 2hrs cruising in Skadar Lake, on the way to Budva (Virpazar - Lesendro - Andrijska gora – Virpazar)

Proceed driving to Budva (1hour)

Overnight in Budva: Hotel Moskva 4* or Hotel Bracera 4* or Adria 4* or similar

Day 02: Budva – Cetinje – Njegusi – Kotor – Budva (150km – 2h30min)

Today after breakfast we'll discover the colorful round tour through the urban and rural areas of Montenegro. Montenegro is a land abundant natural and cultural contrasts. It is such an original mixture of eastern and western cultural influences. Our first stop will be Cetinje the Old Royal Capital of Montenegro, raw mountains of Lovcen, peaceful Njegusi village, breathtaking Boka Bay of Kotor from another perspective, and medieval town of Kotor.

Upon arrival to Kotor, we'll start the walking tour. UNESCO included this town into the list of the World's Heritage Sites. Once you enter the Old town through the Sea Gate, the old Clock Tower will welcome you and tell you that you are right on time to explore the charming streets and squares of this wealthy town. Visit of the Cathedral of Saint Tryphon, patron and protector of Kotor, will appear in front of you and amaze you with its simple beauty.

Free time to wander around and to enjoy shopping souvenirs or grab a cup of ice-cream.

Only 40 minutes to get back to Budva for your dinner and accommodation

Overnight in Budva: Hotel Moskva 4* or Hotel Bracera 4* or Adria 4* or similar

Day 03: Budva – Shkodra – Fishte – Shkoder (155km – 3h30min) (Montenegro/Albania)

The journey start today towards North Albania, to Shkodra city for 2.5 hours, with a stop on the way to take some nice photos of St. Stephan. Sveti Stefan is the jewel in the Budva Riviera's (already adomed) crown. It's got everything: Illustrious history; Celeb sightings; Stunning beauty. We proceed to Shkoder, wedged between the mysterious Accursed Mountains and the glittering

expanse of Lake Skadar, many visitors use Shkoder merely as a gateway for the Albanian Alps, but this oddly refreshing town is certainly worth a visit in its own. Shkoder is also known as the center of the Albanian Catholicism and a perfect proof of the fact that all different religions can adjoin in one country. The main historic and cultural attraction is the castle of Rozafa, a monumental testament to the beauty of an everlasting fortress.

But the surprises are not finished yet. So keep driving and spend some time in a countryside farm at the hills of Fishta village in south of Shkoder. For all of you that love lots of different food, sate your desires with our ever changing local and seasonally inspired small plates.

Way back to Shkodra and have some free time (40min)

Overnight in Shkodra: Hotel Colosseo 4* or similar

Day 04: Shkoder – Koman Lake – Prizren (160km – 4h30min) (Albania/Kosovo)

Breakfast, check out of your hotel. Transfer to Koman Dam (2h30min). Board the ferry and enjoy a 2 ½ hour sail in Koman Lake amidst stunning panoramic views of the Drini River Valley, canyons, waterfalls and amazing rock formations. Arrive in Fierza in the afternoon and continue to Decani Monastery for a visit. Decan Monastery is a stunning white building with a small cupola founded in the 14th century. Go inside the church to admire the frescoes with various scenes from the Bible

Continue driving to Prizren 1h30min.

Overnight in Prizren: Hotel Kacinari 4*, or Hotel Centrum 3* or similar

Day 05: Prizren – Gracanica – Skopje (180km – 3hrs) (Kosovo/North Macedonia)

This morning we'll discover Prizren, the cradle of cultural wealth of Kosovo people. The walking tour will explore the Old town with its Ottoman bridge, water fountain, their unique mosques and orthodox churches. Visit Sinan Pasha Mosque, Stone Bridge and Shadervan.

Departure to Skopje/North Macedonia, with stop en route to visit another beautiful monastery of Gracanica. Southeast of Pristina city is the Gračanica Monastery, built about 1313–21 under the Serbian king Stefan Uroš II Milutin. The monastery is a fine work of Balkan architecture containing valuable frescoes and in 2006 it was designated a UNESCO World Heritage site.

You have possibility to have lunch in an Ethno House near the Monastery.

Continue our driving to Skopje (1h30min)

Upon arrival, start with the visit of Skopje, known for the contrast between old ottoman town and the modern city. The tour will highlight the Old Town, the narrow streets in the Old Bazaar, the Memorial House of Mother Teresa and the beautiful quay of the Macedonian river, "Vardar", an exciting tourist destination. Dinner and overnight in Skopje

Overnight in Skopje: Hotel Sultan Modern 4*, or similar

Day 06: Skopje – Vergina – Thessaloniki (340km – 4hrs) (North Macedonia/Greece)

Enjoy a morning drive on eastern part of Macedonia towards the northern Greece.

Continue driving to Thessaloniki for dinner and overnight (1h)

Overnight in Thessaloniki: Hotel Anatolia 4* or similar

Day 07: Thessaloniki

Breakfast in the hotel. Meet the guest and start the tour of Thessaloniki, one of the important city in Greece. Thessaloniki is home to numerous notable Byzantine monuments, including the Paleochristian and Byzantine monuments of Thessalonica, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, as well as several Ottoman and Sephardic Jewish structures.

After tour possibility for optional lunch

Afternoon, enjoy in leisure a promenade along the seaside.

Overnight in Thessaloniki: Hotel Anatolia 4* or similar

Day 08: Thessaloniki – Airport (20km – 40min)

Breakfast and check out of the hotel. Free time until your departure to the Airport.

G006 8 Days Albania - Ohrid

A trip through ancient historical sites; medieval towns and magic natural landscapes between Albania and North Macedonia

Day 01: Tirana Airport – Kruja – Durres (70 km - 2hrs.)

Welcome in Albania! Meet the guide and driver at the airport and transfer to the first site, Kruja. Upon your arrival, start touring the medieval fortress of Kruja hill town. The walking tour will take you through the cobble stone pathway of Ottoman bazaar, with wooden shops and displays of various gifts and antique household items.

Continuation to Durres
Overnight in Durres: Hotel Arvi 4* or similar

Day 02: Durres – Ardenica – Apollonia – Vlora (180km – 3h30min)

Today, after breakfast, we'll start walking along the Venetian Tower and the Byzantine stretch of wall, "the old-and-new-in the same time" promenade of Durres. We'll explore the ruins of town forum, roman baths, city center, town hall, Roman Amphitheatre and Venetian tower a panoramic display of discoveries and urban planning of this once important city.

Afterwards, we'll board the coach and drive for one hour to Ardenica Monastery. Visit of St. Mary Church, one of the most beautiful Byzantine churches in Albania, dating back to XIII century.

After a delicious lunch, at a local restaurant, we'll head to Apollonia Archaeologic Site. The walking tour of the Apollonia Archaeological Park includes the encircling wall, the monuments of Agonothetes, the Library, the Odeon, the Portico, Archaeological Museum and the Church of St. Mary.

One more hour drive to the hotel in Vlora
Overnight in Vlora: Hotel Partner 4* - or similar

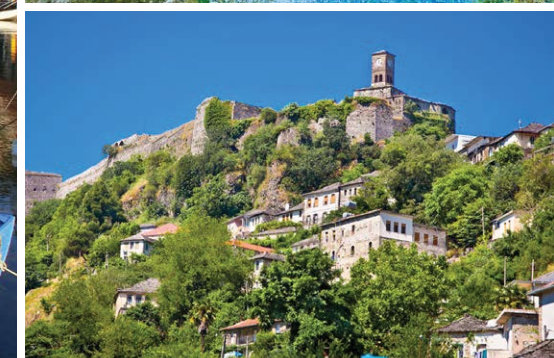

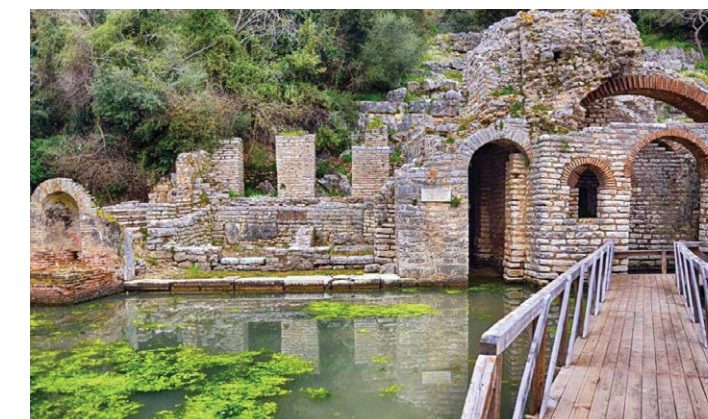

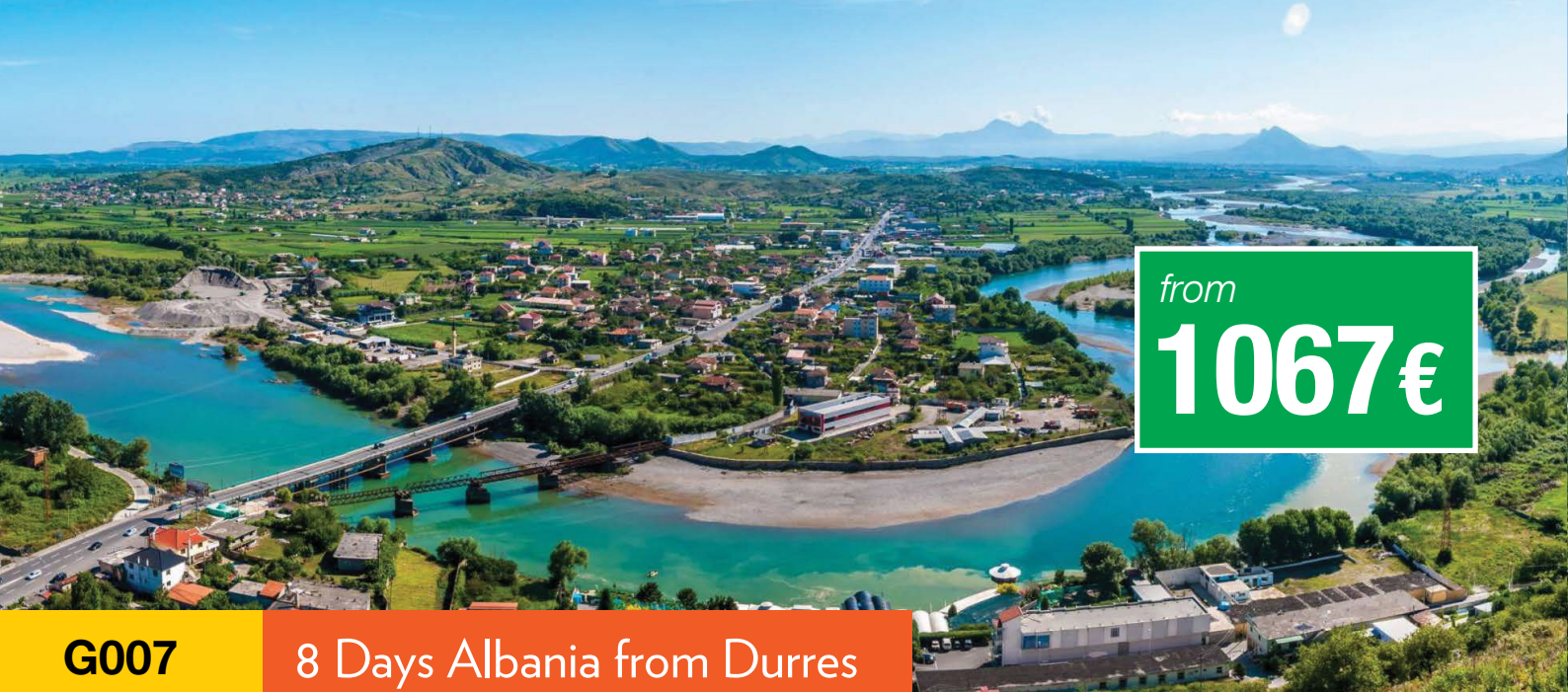

Day 3: Belgrade – Novi Sad – Budapest (400 km – 5hrs) (SERBIA&HUNGARY)

With so many religions, cultures in this region and borders that have shifted many times in the last century alone, there's a unique mix of experiences to be had. The most impressive landmark found within Sarajevo's Old Town is the Gazi Husrev-beg Mosque, built in 1532. Off along the outside of the Bezistan Covered Market, you'll find the open air ruins of the Tašilhan, an Ottoman caravanserai from the 16th century, although only foundations of the building now remain.

Overnight in Sarajevo: Hotel Bristol 4* or similar

Day 02: Sarajevo

Today we'll learn more about the war of Sarajevo. A journey into the tunnel of Sarajevo, a 700 meter underground track which, for the inhabitants of the Bosnian capital, meant the difference between life and death. For the people of Sarajevo "the tunnel" is the symbol of courage and survival.

Day 03: Sarajevo – Mostar – Split (Croatia) (275km – 5h30min)

Today after breakfast, our drive to Mostar, passing along the Neretva River will be just stunning. Lots of sights to see and places to stop. The road snakes through a few tunnels and along very picturesque gorges. Little villages dot the way and there are quite a few places to stop for refreshments.

Once in the town, take some time to explore, perhaps admiring the famous arched bridge and visiting the Old Bazaar alongside historical mosques and the Turkish House. Mostar has a charm like nowhere else. It's a very compact

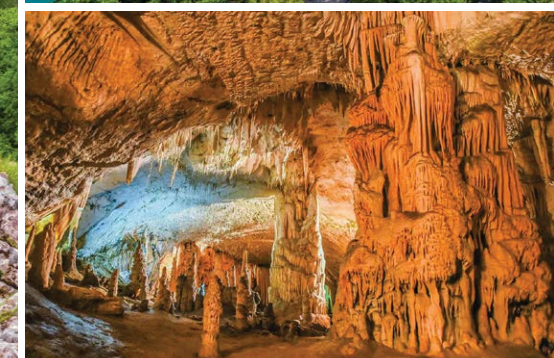

The story of amazing Split dates back to ancient Roman times. Split most famous feature is its Diocletian's Palace (listed under UNESCO World Heritage Sites) consider to be most spectacular. Built towards the end of the 3rd century AD, is the most significant Roman site in Croatia. Originally created for the Emperor, the old city of Split was constructed for his retirement.

Wander around by your own until our departure to Plitvice National Park for dinner and overnight.

Day 05: Plitvice National Park – Zagreb (150km – 2h30min)

The second most visited turistic town in Albania, a typical ottoman town with a very interesting and lively bazar where you can see live how the people work on the crafts which they sell on spot. You may visit Ethnographic Museum to understand better the way of living in the northern part of Albania.
Depart to Theth with stop en route to Shkodra for refreshments. Free time or you may visit Rozafa Fortress. It is surrounded by the waters of three rivers; the Drini, Buna, and Kiri, and it offers an amazing panorama of rivers and Shkodra Lake from the top of the fortress. Continue driving to Theth (2h)
Overnight in Theth:: Guest House Marashi or similar

Day 04: Theth (hiking)

Breakfast in the hotel, and start with a 40-minute walk by visiting the Church and the Grunas waterfall. It is a natural attraction, 30 meters high. All its water derives entirely from a rock and from snow water. Afterward, we have a short visit to the "Kulla" (tower) of Theth. There, men would hide for protection from families with whom they were engaged in a blood feud. Meanwhile, they would try to find a "peaceful" solution between the families. Locally they call this impressive stone tower as Kulla e Ngujimit (lock-in tower).
We recommend visiting:
– the church (located in the village)
– the lock-in tower ("Kulla e Ngujimit", located in the village)
– the Grunas waterfall, which is around 45 minutes walking from the village

There are four cafes along the way, two on the Theth side and two closer to Valbona. All of the cafes have water springs so bring a reusable water bottle. There is quite a long way between café 2 and 3 including a stop at the peak. So make sure you have enough food and water.

Day 06: Valbona Np – Fierza & Koman Lake – Fishta – Berat (ferry boat + Agritourism Mrizi i Zanave) (280km – 5.5hrs)

Breakfast in the hotel, check out. Drive to Fierza Ferry Terminal (40min). Embark the ferry and enjoy a 2.5 hours sailing in Fierza & Koman Lakes amidst stunning panoramic views of the Drini River Valley, canyons, waterfalls and amazing rock formations.
Upon arrival, board the bus and transfer for lunch in an amazing agritourist farm: Mrizi i Zanave in the village of Fishte.
Is not just a meal, is a pure show of the Albanian cuisine, brought in table directly from the land in the finest way.
Continue driving to Berat for 3hrs
Overnight in Berat: Hotel Grand White City 4* or similar

Day 07: Berat – Rafting (Osumi Canyons) – Berat (120 km – 4hrs)

Breakfast at hotel and depart to Osum Canyon (2hrs). Arrival at Hambull- Camping location where preparation on rafting takes place (45 min in total). The tour is supposed to last from 2.5 – 3 hours (depending on water level). The level of difficulty is Grade II - III.
Rafting will provide magnificent scenery as you float by the Canyon walls and will certainly make for a memorable experience.

Breakfast at the hotel and head on the way toward the Cape of Rodon on the Albanian Adriatic coast between Durres and Tirana. More than the historical and cultural part with the visit of the St. Anthony Church and Skanderbeg castle, is worth for the fantastic nature, the fresh air, the panoramic view.
Upon arrival, a short introduction will be organized with a view to having a clearer idea related to kayak utilization and safety equipment. Continue our drive to Tirana.,

Day 04: Tirana – Ohrid (Albania– North Macedonia) (135km – 3hrs)

Today, before leaving for Ohrid, we'll visit Tirana and understand more about the turbulent and trisful history of Albania. We will start the visit from Skanderbeg Square, and the Et'hem Bey Mosque, one of the most precious buildings of the nation dating from the late Eighteenth Century. Other important buildings are the National Historic Museum decorated with a large socialist painting that shows

Overnight in Ohrid: Hotel SU 4* or similar



Day 06: Ohrid – Bitola – Thessaloniki (North Macedonia – Greece) (295km – 5hrs)

Breakfast at the hotel, and it's time to depart to Bitola, an administrative, cultural, industrial, commercial, and educational centre. Upon arrival, visit Heraklea Lycentis, showing its development through the phases of Hellenistic, Roman and Early-Christianity period. In addition to the numerous and various remains of the material culture which are discovered, nowadays Heraclea is famous and important due to its floor mosaics.
After the visit of Heraklea, proceed to the city center for free time and Lunch at Sirok Sokak (Wide Street) - the main and busiest street in Bitola, with numerous shops, bars, restaurants, the theater, city museum, galleries, and cafes.
Proceed driving to Thessaloniki, with stop en route before border, for the tour and taste the Macedonian Wine. (Please note time difference between North Macedonia & Greece: 0/+1).
Overnight in Thessaloniki: Hotel Anatolia 4* or similar

Day 07: Thessaloniki

Breakfast at the hotel and start the visit of Thessaloniki, the second largest city of Greece and the most important centre of the area. Built near the sea (at the back of the Thermaikos Gulf), it is a modern metropolis bearing the marks of its stormy history and its cosmopolitan character, which give it a special beauty and charm. Take a tour in the centre of Thessaloniki. The ancient forum (dated to the late 2nd or the early 3rd century AD) with squares, porticoes, additional buildings and odeum (293-395 AD), the palace complex of Galerius Maximianus (4th c. AD), the thermae, the hippodrome, the temples and other monuments and moveable finds (among them mosaics of exquisite art) brought to light in excavations and surveys. In the south square, is the famous Stoa of the Idols, which was two-storeyed and lavishly decorated.
Enjoy free time in Thessaloniki
Overnight in Thessaloniki: Hotel Anatolia 4* or similar

Day 08: Thessaloniki – Philippi – Kavala (Greece) (180km – 3hrs)

After breakfast at the hotel, leave Thessaloniki and drive for 2 hours to Philippi archaeological site. Philippi was an important city in eastern Macedon which flourished in the Hellenistic, Roman, and Byzantine Periods. Today the archaeological site has substantial remains including a theatre and four basilicas, and listed by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site.
After the visit of Filippi, departure for Kavala, built over the ruins of the previous Byzantine fortress and surrounded by well-preserved walls, Kavala is considered to be the "access door" of Christianity in Western Europe because Apostle Paul, following one vision, landed there to bring "the good news".
Free time at your disposal to wander around the city
Overnight in Kavala: Hotel Egnatia 4* or similar

Day 09: Kavala – Tekirdag – Istanbul (Greece – Turkey) (455km – 6hrs)

Breakfast and check out of the hotel. Today we'll drive to Turkey, but before arriving in Istanbul, it is worth to stop for refreshments and a short visit to Tekirdag. Please note: border crossing procedures – guests should keep ID documents handy. Visit the city center of Tekirdag with its Ataturk statue. The panoramic sightseeing includes the church of Panagia and a typical Turkish house, nowadays it is Rakozci Museum. Continue with the journey to Istanbul.
Overnight in Istanbul: Hotel Morione & Spa 4* or similar

Then there is the possibility for a boat trip to the island. Visit the The Church of Mary the Queen, which is located on a small island in the middle of Lake Bled.

Overnight in Ljubljana: Hotel Lev 4* or similar

Day 09: Bled – Hallstatt – Salzburg (300km – 5.5hrs) (Slovenia – Austria)

Breakfast at the hotel, check out. Board the coach and transfer approximately for 4hrs to Hallstatt. After lunch, orientation tour of Hallstatt. Hallstatt is considered one of the most beautiful villages in Austria and possibly in Europe. The fairytale town is actually included in the list of World Heritage Sites by UNESCO since 1997. Continue driving to Salzburg for 1.5h. Photo stop: Mozart House, the Mirabell Garden. Upon arrival, check in at the hotel and prepare for dinner. Overnight in Salzburg: Hotel NN 4* or similar

Day 10: Salzburg – Hallein Salt Mine – Salzburg (44km – 1.5h) (Austria)

Stroll around old town of Budva. Budva Old Town lies on a small peninsula and represents a treasure chest of culture heritage.

Overnight in Budva: Hotel Moskva 4* or similar

Day 08: Budva – Shkodra – Tirana (197km – 4hrs)

After breakfast in the hotel, check out, and depart for Shkodra/ALBANIA (90 km – 2h). Shkodra, known as the "capital of north Albania" it is one of the oldest cities in the country and the main tourist attraction is Rozafa Castle. We shall explore the capital city of Albania, including some of the historical highlights, as city center, Skanderbeg Statue, Et'hem Bey Mosque, Clock tower, Italian buildings and Martyrs of the Nation Boulevard. Visit the ex-communist buildings, painted with vibrant colors and the expansion of city.

Overnight in Tirana: Hotel Metro or Colosseo 4* or similar

Day 09: Tirana – Ohrid (135km - 3hrs)

Breakfast in the hotel, check out and transfer to Ohrid/North Macedonia (135 km – 3hrs). Due to the large number of churches and monasteries, the city of Ohrid is known as Balkan and European Jerusalem. It is also known as the "City of Light", a literal translation of its old name, Lychnidos. The Ohrid region is included in the UNESCO World Heritage.

Afternoon free or optional boat tour in Ohrid Lake and visit of St. Naum Monastery.

Overnight in Ohrid: Hotel SU 4* or similar

Day 10: Ohrid – Kalambaka (300km – 4.5hrs)

Breakfast at the hotel, check out and depart to Kalambaka/ Greece (300 km), with stop en route for refreshment in Bitola. Please note time difference between North Macedonia & Greece: 0/+1

Overnight in Kalambaka: Hotel Meteora 4* or similar

Day 11: Kalambaka (10km – 20min)

Breakfast at the hotel. Tour of the Monasteries. METEORA - is actually a religious place with many Byzantine churches and Monasteries. The special characteristic of Meteora is that it looks like hanging rocks and that monasteries are all built on top of rocks, overlooking a beautiful valley. Free afternoon

Overnight in Kalambaka: Hotel Meteora 4* or similar

Day 12: Kalambaka – Delphi – Athens (420km – 6hrs)

Breakfast at the hotel, check out and depart to Delphi (235 km – 3.5hrs).

Explore the famous UNESCO-listed Classical site of Delphi Archaeological Site considered to be the Center of the World in Ancient Greece. The archaeological site of Delphi includes two sanctuaries, dedicated to Apollo and Athena, and other buildings, mostly intended for sports. Visitors arriving from Athens first encountered the sanctuary of Athena Pronaia - that is, Athena who is before the temple of Apollo. Within the walls were the famous Tholos, the symbol of Delphi today, and the remains of three temples dedicated to the goddess. After lunch, board the bus and continue to Athens (190 km – 3 hrs.) Overnight in Kalambaka: Hotel the Stanley 4* or similar

Day 13: Athens (20km – 40min)

Breakfast at the hotel, start the visit. Athens Sightseeing & Acropolis & Museum Tour. A large part of the town's historic center has been converted into a 3-kilometre pedestrian zone (the largest in Europe), leading to the major archaeological sites ("archaeological park"), reconstructing – to a large degree – the ancient landscape.

The cable car is the longest in the Balkans with scenic views. (15min cable car ride – up to the mountain). We start to descend downhill Mountain Dajti with our bike towards Surrel and then head towards Farka Lake to only finish our tour at the Elbasan Road. 24 km, elevation+191m / - 1050m
Overnight in Tirana: Hotel Metro or Colosseo 4* or similar

Day 03: Tirana – Theth (Hiking) (188km – 5hrs driving time)

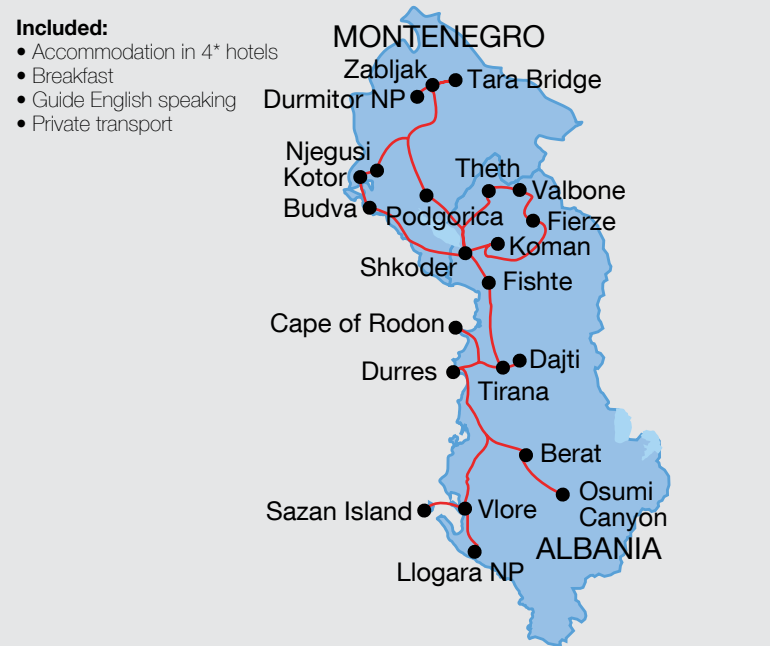
Breakfast in the hotel, check out and depart to Theth with stop en route to Shkodra for refreshments.
Time for lunch on the way to Theth. Afternoon tour will start with a 40-minute walk by visiting the Church and the Grunas waterfall. It is a natural attraction, 30 meters high. All its water derives entirely from a rock and from snow water. Afterward, we have a short visit to the "Kulla" (tower) of Theth. There, men would hide for protection from families with whom they were engaged in a blood feud. Meanwhile, they would try to find a "peaceful" solution between the families. Locally they call this impressive stone tower as Kulla e Ngujimit (lock-in tower)...
We recommend visiting:
– the church (located in the village)
– the lock-in tower ("Kulla e Ngujimit", located in the village)
– the Grunas waterfall, which is around 45 minutes walking from the village (one-way)
– the canyon, around 20 minutes walking from the waterfall (one-way)
– the Blue Eye, which is around 2,5 hours walking from the village (one-way). It is possible to go there by car
Overnight in Theth
Accommodation: Guesthouse Marashi or similar

Day 04: Theth – Valbona NP (Hiking)

Breakfast and check out. Today we'll start hiking trail from Theth to Valbona National Park Info about the Theth to Valbona Hike
Distance: 17km
Time: 6-8 hours
Difficulty: Medium (moderate level of fitness required)
Water: Streams and small stalls/cafes available every 2-3 hours
The hike from Theth to Valbona takes you to the top of a mountain and back down the other side. A lot of the way is steep and gravelly but there are also some flatter parts.
Overnight in Valbona: Guesthouse Margjeka or similar

Day 07: Durmitor National Park (jeep safari) (85km – 4.5hrs)

Breakfast at the hotel. Today we'll drive in jeep tour, which is packed with excitement and is called the "Ring of Durmitor" as it is a real full circle journey around the majestic Durmitor Mountains, for a relaxed activity journey that encapsulates the best of the area's nature and scenery. The Jeep tour will take our guests across the panoramas of Zabljak, at an average height of 1800 m above sea level.

Free time for shopping
Continue driving to Budva (40 min)
Free time
Overnight in Budva: Accommodation: Hotel Moskva 4* or similar

Day 09: Budva – Fishte (agritourism mrizi i zanave) – berat (280km – 5hrs)

Breakfast at the hotel, check out. Board the bus and drive back to Albania. On the way to Berat we'll stop for lunch in an amazing agritourist farm: Mrizi i Zanave in the village of Fishte. Is not just a meal, is a pure show of the Albanian cuisine, brought in table directly from the land in the finest way.
Continue our journey to Berat. Tour of the "City of one thousand windows", declared as a Museum City". Berat. The town is composed of 3 parts: Gorica, situated on the far side of the river; Mangalem, situated on the fortress side of the river and the Residential quarter within the fortress known as Kalaja. The old part of the city has some religious buildings like mosque and Byzantine churches.
Overnight in Berat: Hotel Grand White City 4* or similar

Day 10: Berat – Rafting (osumi canyons) – Berat (120 km – 4hrs)

Breakfast at hotel and depart to Osumi Canyon (2hrs). Arrival at Hambull - Camping location where preparation on rafting takes place (45 min in total). The tour is supposed to last from 2.5 – 3 hours (depending on water level). Rafting will provide magnificent scenery as you float by the Canyon walls and will certainly make for a memorable experience

Breakfast at the hotel, check out and departure to Viora coastal city for 1 hour 30minutes. Upon arrival at Viora harbor, embark the boat to Sazan Island.
Sailing to Sazan Island and Karaburun Peninsula
Sazan Island, located off the coast of Albania, has a pristine coastline, but it is still shrouded in mystery, even to most Albanians. That's because the island once was a military base and into the island was created a small town for officers' families. Then we will sail along the Karaburun peninsula where we will explore the mystical caves, exotic bays and rocky beaches in the crystal waters of the Ionian Sea.
Sailing back to Viora, board the bus and drive towards Llogara National Park (1h)
Overnight in Llogara NP: Hotel Alpin 3* or similar

Day 12: Llogara (paragliding) – Durres

Breakfast at the hotel, check out. Today we'll try another breathtaking experience. Paragliding! It makes perfect sense as Albania's landscape is ideal for it. This one in particular is beautiful, as it begins from the snowy mountain caps and concludes on the beautiful shores of the Ionian!
Board the bus and drive to Durres, with stop en route for refreshments
Board the bus and continue driving to Jale
Overnight in Durres: Hotel Arvi 4* or similar

Day 13: Durres – Cape of Rodon (kayaking) – Durres (100km – 2.5hrs)

Breakfast at the hotel and head on the way toward the Cape of Rodon on the Albanian Adriatic coast between Durres and Tirana. More than the historical and cultural part with the visit of the St. Anthony Church and Skanderbeg castle, is worth for the fantastic nature, the fresh air, the panoramic view. After breakfast at the hotel, board the coach and drive to Topkapi Palace, once the main residence for the Ottoman Sultans and administrative headquarters for the Ottoman Empire from the 15th to the 19th centuries housing an exquisite collection of crystal, silver, and Chinese porcelain, robes worn by the sultans and their families, the famous jewels of the Imperial Treasury. Drive back to the city center – and walk around in Sultan Ahmet Square. This area has some popular tourist spots, all within a walkable distance from each other. Hagia Sophia and the Blue Mosque are of course the most obvious attractions here. After the visit you may enjoy lunch and of course explore the alleys of the Grand Bazaar. The Grand Bazaar's lively maze of shops has a bustling spirit that is more than any ordinary shopping experience. It is one of the oldest and largest indoor markets in the world with more than 4,000 shops. Overnight in Istanbul: Hotel NN 4* or similar

Day 03: Istanbul (TURKEY)

Breakfast at the hotel and keep exploring Istanbul, wander along Istiklal Street, in the heart of modern Istanbul: a shopping street at heart, it is always crowded with locals and tourists alike. Roughly a 15-minute walk along Istiklal, depending on where you start. Istiklal Street dead-ends into Taksim Square, also known as the center of modern Istanbul. Meet the local host at the Airport and transfer to Skopje: (20 km - 40min, considering traffic)

Upon arrival, accommodation and relax at the hotel & time for lunch

The capital of North Macedonia, a city with the beautiful quay of the Macedonian river "Vardar", the narrow streets in the Old Bazaar which is the biggest bazaar preserved in the Balkans today. Our panoramic tour will explore the old town and its bazaar, Mustafa Pasha Mosque; Daut Pasha Hammam; the Old Caravan Saraje; monuments of the Islamic architecture; the Stone Bridge; the Memorial House of Mother Theresa and the old Railway station

Day 2: Skopje – Bitola – Ohrid (North Macedonia) (228 km – 4.5hrs)

Breakfast at hotel. This morning we'll travel towards south of North Macedonia. Our first stop will be in Heraklea Lyncestis, famous for its dazzling mosaics, ancient theater and Roman

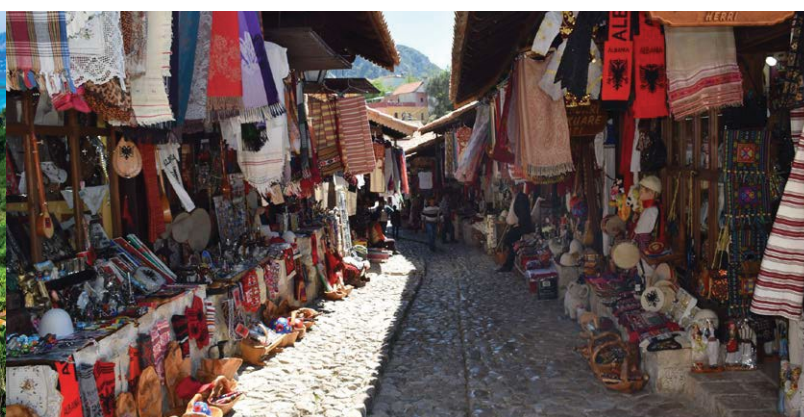
Proceed our drive to Bitola (10min) city center for lunch and a nice walk through Sirok Sokak

Bitola historically known as Monastir or is one of the oldest cities on the territory in the Republic of Macedonia. It was founded as Heraclea Lyncestis in the middle of the 4th century BC by Philip II of Macedon. During the Ottoman rule the city together with Salonica were the two reigning cities of Ottoman Rumelia. The drive will continue for 1h30min to Ohrid

Overnight in Ohrid: Hotel SU 4* - or similar

Day 3: Ohrid – St. Naum – Ohrid (North Macedonia) (70 km – 2hrs)

Breakfast in the hotel, and start the tour of Ohrid Old Town, which is situated at the lake side resort of Ohrid, classified as a UNESCO's World Cultural Heritage site. Nicknamed the 'Jerusalem of the Balkans', Ohrid is one of the oldest settlements in Europe, and was once considered to be the epicenter of religion



and Slavic culture.

Visit Old Town, St. Bogorodica Perivlepta Church, St Sophia Cathedral and the stunning St. John Kaneo Church (outside only).

Enjoy a boat ride on this extraordinary lake

Afternoon visit to a monastic complex, known for its rich history of orthodox religion, some of the painting achievements and wood carving, displayed within the church of St. Naum, a priest and scholar with a famous legacy.

Overnight in Ohrid: Hotel SU 4* - or similar

Day 4: Ohrid – Berat (North Macedonia – Albania) (195km – 4hrs)

Breakfast at the hotel, check out and depart towards Berat/Albania, with stop en route for refreshments (Please note border procedures).

Upon our arrival, we'll have time for optional lunch or Tour & Wine testing in Cobo winery

Wine testing at COBO Winery (Optional)

The Çobo Winery currently consist of several cultivated vineyards, a spacious kulla (a form of traditional Albanian architecture), and the winery itself, and a wine presentation room, elegantly constructed and furnished in the Berat style. A tour of the facilities includes an extensive viewing of the wine making process and detailed explanations, punctuated by alternating poignant and comic vignettes that paint a glowing picture of the family's history and the origins of their wines.

Our visit to Berat medieval town, listed under UNESCO Heritage, will start from the Fortress. Berat is known as the "City of thousand windows" or "City of windows one above the other". The town is composed of 3 parts; Gorica, situated on the far side of the river; Mangalem, situated on the fortress side of the river and the Residential quarter within the fortress known as Kalaja. The old part of the city has some religious buildings like mosque and Byzantine churches. Visit The Fortres and Onufri Museum situated inside Orthodox Cathedral of the Dormition of St. Mary

Overnight in Berat: Hotel Grand White City 4* - or similar

Day 5: Berat – Vjora – Albanian riviera – Porto Palermo – Saranda (Albania) (235km – 5h30min)

Breakfast, check out of your hotel. Departure to Saranda, with several stops en route for pictures and refreshments. Enjoy the scenic mountain ride, descending the rocky shore and pristine beaches of Ionian Sea, offering photo opportunities of the natural landscape, unique village settings, and fortresses. Visit the Castel of Ali Pasha Tepelena in Porto Palermo. Continue driving to Saranda (50 km)

Overnight in Saranda: Hotel Brillant 4* - or similar

Day 6: Saranda – Butrint – Saranda/ Albania (40km – 1h30min)

Breakfast at the hotel and drive for 40 min to Butrinti Archaeological Park. This impressive walking tour will stir your imagination about the ancient world during the peak of the Roman power and the classical Greek mythology. Under the Byzantine Empire, Butrint became the center of a bishopric in Epirus Vetus. Start the visit with the Asclepius temple, theatre, Roman portico and baths, early Christian baptistery, byzantine basilica, defensive walls and their impressive gates.

Time for lunch and free afternoon in the beach

Overnight in Saranda: Hotel Brillant 4* - or similar

Day 7: Saranda – Gjirokastra – Tirana (Albania) (290km – 5h30min)

Breakfast at hotel. We'll drive (1 hr 15 mins) to the medieval town of Gjirokastra. Stop en route to visit Blue Eye Park, which is a karst spring located on the western slopes of Mount Mali Gjerë in Albania. The water in the inner source is a very dark blue, like the pupil of an eye, and a lighter color of blue as an outer ring - the iris, which gives the impression of a blue eye. Continue driving to Gjirokastra (40 min)

Start with the walking tour of Gjirokastra. Another UNESCO World Heritage Site, the old town is famous for being a well-preserved Ottoman style town, with its fortress overlooking the entire city and the old houses that lean against the slopes of the hills with their beautiful old wooden facades. Visit the Castle and explore the old town and the bazaar, with its characteristic shops and great opportunity to interact with local folks.

After typical lunch, proceed driving to Tirana

Overnight in Tirana: Hotel Colosseo 4* - or similar

Day 8: Tirana (Albania)

Today, after our breakfast at the hotel, we'll start the walking tour of Tirana - the main Italian influenced boulevard, the National Historic Museum, the Bunker1, Pazari i Ri (New bazar - where you can see a green market, fishops and also taste artisanal ice creams). Transfer to Dajti Mountain, which will start with the 'boarding' in the cable car.

Amazing tour of Dajti Mountain National Park. Just 25km east of Tirana is Mt Dajti National Park (1611m). A sky-high, Austrian-made cable car, Dajti Express, takes 15 minutes to rise to (almost) the top. It's a scenic trip over bunkers, forest, farms and hilltops. Experience the breathtaking cable car ride up to the "Dajti balcony," a natural plane formation at an elevation of 1200m, offering spectacular views over Tirana to the Adriatic Sea.



Free time in Tirana

Overnight in Tirana: Hotel Colosseo 4* - or similar

Day 9: Tirana – Kruja – Prizren (Albania – Kosovo) (205km – 4.5hrs)

Breakfast at the hotel and check out. Departure to Prizren/Kosovo, with stop en route after one hour to Kruja hill town

Upon arrival, we'll start the walking tour of Kruja, through the Ottoman bazaar, wooden shops and displays various gifts and antique items for the home. Visit the castle walls, and an old house converted into an ethnographic museum, invites you to a special cultural aspect of life in northern Albania
Free time in the old bazaar and also time for lunch at a local restaurant

Continue our journey to Prizren/Kosovo, passing by spectacular views of high mountains; amazing rivers and artificial lake of Fierza, surrounded by hills and mountains, gives off a fine mist that rises upwards, contrasting with the green trees that frame it like a border.

After crossing border we continue for approximately 20 min to Prizren

Overnight in Prizren: Accommodation: Hotel Kacinari 4*, or Hotel Centrum 3* or similar

Day 10: Prizren – Decan – Pej – Prizren (Kosovo) (210km – 4hrs)

Breakfast at the hotel. We start with the visit of Prizren, known as the cultural capital of Kosovo. Over the years it seems to have been ruled and influenced by Illyrians, Dardanians, Romans, Serbs, Ottomans, Italians, Germans, and Yugoslavian communists. Today it is home to several mosques, a large castle, a few churches, and beautiful old Ottoman buildings, a bazaar area, an old town full of cobbled streets, and a stone ottoman bridge over the river that runs through the center.

Board the coach and drive for 1hour and a half to Decan for an important visit, part of Serbian orthodox culture Decani Monastery, a stunning white building with a small cupola, built by the Serbian King - St. Stefan of Dečani in 1335. A UNESCO World Heritage Site, Dečani possesses a unique church constructed in a mixture of Romanic, Gothic and Byzantine styles

Proceed our drive to Peja for lunch and free time in the old bazaar
On our drive back to Prizren, we may stop en route to Stone Castle Winery for an optional Wine Tour and Testing 1h30min
Come with us to taste and to reveal the secret of the highest quality grape and producing approachable, premium wines, while combining the latest technological advances with traditional winemaking methods.
Our drive will continue for 45 min to Prizren for dinner and accommodation

Overnight in Prizren: Accommodation: Hotel Kacinari 4*, or Hotel Centrum 3* or similar

Day 11: Prizren – Shkodra – Budva (Kosovo – Albania – Montenegro) (290km – 5h30min)

Breakfast and check out of the hotel. Today we'll drive back to Northern part of Albania, but the surprises are not finished yet. So keep driving and spend some time in a countryside farm at the hills of Fishta village in south of Shkoder - an amazing agritourist farm: Is not just a meal, is a pure show of the Albanian cuisine, brought in table directly from the land in the finest way.

Proceed driving to Shkodra for half an hour and upon arrival, start the visit of the city, which was known as an old artisan center, as well road and river junction with a considerable transit trade, also known to be the center of Albanian Catholicism, Culture and Harmony between different religions. The main cultural attraction is Rozafa Fortress, rising majestically upon a rocky hill west of the city, the outcroppings and battlements paint a blazing picture against the setting sun.

Our journey will continue towards Montenegro. Please note border procedures

Overnight in Budva: Hotel Moskva 4* - or similar

Day 12: Budva – Cetinje – Kotor – Budva (Montenegro) (110km – 3hrs)

This morning after our breakfast, we'll drive to Cetinje, the former royal capital of Montenegro, which is sitting at the foot of the Lovcen mountains. Visit of King Nicola's Museum, the residence of the last Montenegrin ruler Nikola I Petrović Njegoš, in continuation of the tradition of collecting and carefully preserving the materials on the Montenegrin past.

Free time for refreshments and then continue our journey to Kotor. Enjoy wonderful view of Budva Rivera on Adriatic Sea
Upon arrival, time for lunch in Kotor and then start the visit Kotor Old Town. Day 13: Budva – Dubrovnik – Mostar (Montenegro – Croatia – Bosnia & Herzegovina) (235 km – 4.5hrs)

Breakfast at hotel. Check out, and depart to Mostar, via Dubrovnik. (Please note: border procedures Mnt/Cr; Cr/BiH)

If you enjoyed Montenegro, today on the way to Mostar, we'll stop for a visit to Dubrovnik, but believe it or not, the road to get there and the view over Dubrovnik is indeed magnificent

Proceed driving to Mostar for approximately three hours, via Metkovic border

Overnight in Mostar: Hotel Bristol 4* - or similar

Day 14: Mostar – Sarajevo (Bosnia & Herzegovina) (130km – 2.5hrs)

We'll visit today Mostar, this little charming old town, listed under UNESCO Heritage sites, enriched with lots of colours of traditional handicrafts productions has played an important role in the history of Bosnia and today, will be target of our visit.. Start the walking tour of Mostar, which was conquered by the Ottoman Empire in the 15th century. Wander in cobble stone streets and feel Mostar as a local. Don't forget to taste the traditional Bosnian Coffee and spend some free time in the bazar.

Time for lunch in a local restaurant
Afternoon transfer to Sarajevo, very scenic drive along Neretva River and admiring lots of minarets and different cultural monuments
Check in at the hotel and relax until time for dinner

Overnight in Sarajevo: Hotel Novotel Bristol 4* - or similar

Day 15: Sarajevo (Bosnia & Herzegovina)

Breakfast at the hotel and start the walking tour of Sarajevo Old Town. Sarajevo is one of the most oriental and culturally diverse cities in Europe, and had spent over 300 years under Turkish rule until the Austro-Hungarians arrived in the late nineteenth century.

Explore the old town and the bazaar, with its characteristic shops and great opportunity to interact with local folks.
